Young Authors' Faire

The Tulare County Office of Education is sponsoring a Young Authors' Faire. This event will be held February 27 – March 2, 2012, in the Elderwood Room of the TCOE Doe Avenue Complex, 7000 Doe Avenue, Visalia. We would like to encourage each school to participate in this great event.

There are three ways in which you could join in this event.

First, encourage your students to write and submit entries. Second, encourage teachers and parents to come by during the week to read books submitted by students from throughout Tulare County. Their comments are welcomed and appreciated by the young writers. Third, encourage authors, parents and teachers to attend the Young Authors' Reception. Enclosed you will find an invitation to be sent to the participants' families asking them to attend the reception. Please be sure to send this invitation to the family of any authors whose work was submitted.

1. The Tulare County Young Authors' Faire is open to kindergarten through eighth grade students in Tulare County. The purpose of the Young Authors' Faire is to showcase original writing, across various genres, by elementary age students in Tulare County. The Young Authors' Faire is for recognition, not competition. **Each school site may enter 20 books.**
2. Students may write narrative or expository texts. These genres may include ABC books, picture books, poems, fairytales, folktales, myths, legends, mystery, historical, fiction, fantasy, fables and biography.
3. Students are to:
 - create and organize the story idea
 - write and edit the book
 - illustrate and bind the book
5. If using a computer, students need to use a size 10 or greater font.
6. Adults may only act as recorders or typists for children who are too young to do these themselves.
7. Books may be written by one student, a small group of students working together, or a whole class of students. It is suggested that entries be included from several grade levels.
8. Books may be written in any language or combination of languages.
9. Books can be any size, shape, or color. Some examples are:
 - a. shape books

- b. big books
 - c. pop-up books
 - d. flip books
10. Books can be made from various materials.

 11. A variety of art techniques may be utilized when illustrating a book.

Books must be boxed and sent to Tulare County Office of Education, Educational Resource Services, 7000 Doe Avenue, Suite A, Visalia, CA 93291, by **February 10, 2012** (Attention: Sara Torabi/ Maria Ortiz). A Master List (attached) must be enclosed with the boxed books that identifies the school, district, contact person, number of entries, and lists the individual authors, their teachers, and titles. (Boxes may be sent on Tulare County Office of Education delivery trucks by those districts with AV or Library contracts.)
 13. Please note: Although we never judge a book by its cover, it has been our experience over the years that those publications that are visually appealing are picked up and read more frequently than others.
 14. An official school label (enclosed) must be attached to the boxed books.
 15. Each individual book must have an official Young Authors' Fair Comment Page (enclosed) and Book Label (enclosed) inserted inside preferably the back cover, or on front and back inside covers. If necessary, the forms may be reduced to fit the size or shape of the book.
 16. Each entrant will receive a certificate for participating in the Young Authors' Faire. If a book was authored by a group, please indicate how many students were involved so that we may send the correct number of certificates.
 17. Each book will receive a Gold Embossed Seal which will be affixed to the book designating it as a Young Authors' Faire book. All books will be returned to the contact person listed on the Master List upon completion of the Young Authors' Faire.
 18. Please feel free to make as many copies of all or any part of this packet as you wish.
 19. Lastly but not least, we have enclosed an Author/Illustrator Release form to be sent home to each participant's parent/guardian for their signature then submitted to us with your entries.

After the Young Authors' Fair, books will be boxed and returned to the contact person at the school and district from which it was received. Thank you all for your tremendous effort and creativity.
