JOB TITLE: *Audiologist (#2811)*

Job Summary:

Provide and maintain both clinical and educational audiological services to students proposed for or enrolled in educational programs within Tulare County.

Essential Job Functions:

- ▶ Performs comprehensive audiological evaluations for students proposed for, or enrolled in Tulare County instructional programs.
- ▶ Assesses central audiology functions.
- ▶ Evaluates amplification systems.
- ▶ Evaluates student ability to use amplification systems.
- ▶ Makes recommendations about use of the amplification systems, listening devices, with classroom acoustics.
- ▶ Analyzes classroom noise and acoustics.
- ▶ Consults with parents, educators, medical personnel, and agencies.
- ▶ Inservices educators, community, and service clubs.
- ▶ Educates parents, students, and school personnel about the effects of hazardous noise exposure.
- ▶ Manages the use and calibration of audiometric equipment.

Essential Job Requirements - Qualifications

Experience Required:

- ▶ Experience as an audiologist preferred.

Skills, Knowledge and/or Abilities Required:

- ▶ **Skills to:**
 - provide comprehensive audiological evaluation for children ages birth through 21 years
 - assess central auditory function for children ages birth through 21 years
 - evaluate amplification systems used with deaf and hard-of-hearing
 - evaluate student ability to use and benefit from amplification systems
 - provide inservice to educators and community groups
 - educate parents, students and other school personnel about the effects of hazardous noise
- ▶ **Knowledge of:**
 - current audiological procedures and practices for school age children
 - a variety of amplification devices beneficial to the deaf and hard-of-hearing
 - hearing testing equipment used in a typical audiologic test facility
- ▶ **Ability to:**
 - set up and manage sophisticated audiological equipment and procedures
 - make appropriate recommendations regarding the use of amplification devices for the deaf and hard-of-hearing
 - analyze classroom noise and acoustics
 - consult with parents, educators, students and medical personnel.

Education Required:

- ▶ MA, MS, or Au.D. from accredited educational program.

Licenses, Certifications, Bonding, and/or Testing Required:

- ▶ Possess certification or California license in Audiology. Rehabilitation Services Credential in Audiology preferred.
- ▶ Valid California driver's license and proof of automobile insurance.
- ▶ Fingerprint clearance from the Department of Justice and the FBI.
