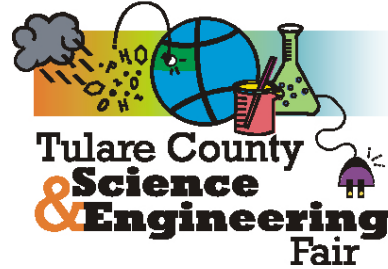

When judges are evaluating the projects, the question of whether a student or students have or have not done the work often arises. To assist the judges, we ask that an authorizing agent certify the work of the student.
